Year 6 Learning Flyer - Term 5

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

In English, the children will be exploring the true story of The Three Little Pigs. They will be creating newspaper report explaining what truly happened! [Watch the video here.](#)

Following this, the pupils will be creating an information text about the circulatory system, in line with our science topic!

Maths

We are starting this term learning about Shape. In this unit, we will be looking at measuring angles and calculating missing angles in triangles, quadrilaterals and polygons. As well as this, we will be looking at position and direction, where we will be reflecting and translating shapes.

After this, we will spend some time recapping all our previous learning.

Science

In Term 5 and 6, we will be investigating the topic Animals including Humans. This term, we will start by understanding the changes that happen to our bodies due to age and choices. We will look into the circulatory system and how humans and animals get energy from food.

History

This term in history, Year 6 will be studying the Suffragettes. We will be exploring democracy in the 19th Century, before moving onto the National Union of Women's Suffrage Societies. As well as this, we will explore the Emmeline Pankhurst and the Anti-Suffrage Campaign.

Spanish

This term, we will be learning about a healthy lifestyle. We will start by learning healthy and unhealthy foods and drinks as well as learning key phrases for healthy and unhealthy habits.

Physical Education

With the sports coach, the children will be developing their skills and understanding of Trigolf.

Our indoor sessions will be focussing on paralympic sports of: seated volleyball, boccia and goalball.

Computing

In computing we will continue to look at Big Data and how this is transferred! We will be exploring how to create a "smart school".

Art

This term year 6 will be exploring collagraph techniques and using a variety of materials to achieve texture and movement. The children will create their own beautiful sea/beach themed collagraphs inspired by the Scottish printmaker Fenella Ross.



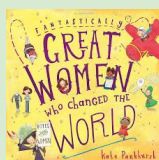
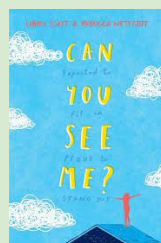
RE Day - Buddhism
