This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

Phonics - Literacy

This term the children in Reception will continue to practise blending sounds so that they can read more complex words. They will also apply their sound knowledge to write words and sentences, focusing on using finger spaces in between their words.

Nursery will continue learning single letter sounds and words that begin with them.

Understanding the World

Throughout the term Nursery and Reception will have the opportunity to look at Traditional tales from around the world. We will look at different homes around the world and consider the materials they are made from. We will also explore different homes and habitats that animals live in.

Maths

Reception will focus on numbers to 20 and count beyond 20. This will include to build numbers, notice patterns in numbers, add, take away and share. They will also manipulate shapes and compose and decompose shapes.

Nursery will be learning about 3D shapes and objects in real life that are the shapes they have learnt about. We will also recap numbers 0 - 10 and attempt to count to 20 using songs and stories to support us.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development


The children will learn to identify and moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally. They will be encouraged to think about the perspective of others when discussing stories and real life situations.

Communication and Language

As the children listen to different
Traditional Tales, they will build up a bank
of high quality vocabulary which they will
use to retell and role play stories. They will
listen to and talk about the stories they
have heard, discussing what happens to
each character and what lessons can be
learned from the endings of the stories.

Expressive Arts and Design

In Nursery and Reception, children will draw inspiration from characters and settings in traditional tales to produce artwork relating to the story. We will also have the opportunity to act out stories, thinking about the emotions and actions of the characters.



RE Day - Buddhism

This term, we will be learning about 'Buddhism' and considering our key question 'Where do we belong?'.

Physical Development

Children in Nursery and Reception will further develop and refine a range of ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming. Children will use their core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or sitting on the floor. In Reception, children will be encouraged to form letters correctly.
