Breakfast Club and After School Club Revised Terms and Conditions 2021/2022

Breakfast Club runs daily from 7.30am until 8.40am and our After School Club from 3:15pm until 6pm. We are acting on parent feedback and offering a new, shorter session for After School Club which will run from 3.15pm until 4.30pm. Please note, the last entry for Breakfast Club is 8.00am.

Places must be booked at least 24 hours in advance via ParentPay. Please see the chart below for the last available time to book a place, without incurring a late fee of £2 per child, per session.

Staffing

- The school will operate a minimum 1:15 staffing ratio; your booking in advance helps us to ensure this.
- All staff hold fully updated DBS and safeguarding checks.
- All staff have completed Emergency First Aid training and Food Hygiene training.

Payment, Cancellation and Late Collection

- Payments and bookings must be made in advance via ParentPay as per the chart overleaf.
- For the After School Club, all children should be collected no later than 6pm when the club closes. Any children not collected by 6.00pm will incur an additional £10 late charge and a further £5 per 15 minutes (this is to cover additional staffing costs).
- If a debt of over £20 occurs then the child will not be able to attend until this is cleared.

Behaviour

- Children are aware of our Behaviour Policy and they are regularly reminded of the expectations.
- Children will be encouraged to use the restorative approach. Unacceptable behaviour is always discussed with the child in order for them to understand why their behaviour is unacceptable.
- Children's pattern of behaviour can often change when under stress. Parents should inform school staff of any change of circumstances that could affect a child's behaviour.
- It may sometimes be necessary to inform the child's parent/carer if unacceptable behaviour continues so that a joint approach can be used.
- In exceptional circumstances the offer of a place at the after school club may be withdrawn.

Food

- Both Breakfast Club and After School Club operate a healthy menu.
- In the After School Club, children will have a light snack. Fruit juice, water and a variety of fruit will also be available.
- Breakfast Club offers a buffet style continental breakfast including: cereal, toast, yoghurts, fruit.
- Dietary needs and allergies can be catered for if we are given prior notification. All dietary requirements should be discussed with the school.
- Please note that the 'Short Session' at After School Club does **not** include food.

Activities and Resources

- A varied range of activities can be enjoyed at After School Club. Including organised games, board games, arts and crafts activities, reading, Lego etc. as well as making use of the school's outside spaces.
