## **RE: Year 5 Educational Visit to Canterbury**



We are very pleased to tell you that we will be visiting <u>Canterbury</u> on <u>Monday 11th</u> <u>October 2021.</u> The visit will form part of our learning during term 1's topic *Anglo-Saxon* settlements. We have secured three events for the children which will take place during our visit: A tour of Canterbury Cathedral, an Anglo-Saxon workshop in the cathedral and a visit to ST. Martin's Church (the first Christian church in England). As well as this, the children will have the opportunity to see Statues of King Ethelbert and Queen Bertha, learning all about their history, in particular its connections to Anglo-Saxon settlements.

On the day, please bring your child to school at the usual time, we will be leaving at **9:00 am** and returning to school at the normal school pick up time of **3:15 pm**. Please ensure that if your child requires any medication that it is sent into school with them. If your child already has their medication, such as an asthma pump in school, then we will take this with us.

The children need to wear a full school uniform, with a warm, waterproof coat and school shoes. Please provide your child with a packed lunch to take with them. However, if your child usually has a school dinner then the kitchen will provide a packed lunch for them to take, please book them in on Parent Pay as normal. The children do not need to bring any spending money but they will need a strong bag (preferably a small rucksack) to put their lunch in, which should not include glass bottles, fizzy drinks, juice or squash.

We ask that a donation of £20.00 is made towards the cost of the trip, payable on Parent Pay. The cost includes entry to the cathedral, the workshop and the coach journey to and from the cathedral. Please note that this trip can only go ahead if we receive sufficient contributions.
