

SOUTH BOROUGH PRIMARY SCHOOL Year 3 Learning Flyer - Term 1

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

In English, the children will be writing a description based on a short film called, 'La Luna'. We will be spending time exploring a range of vocabulary to enable them to create a detailed description as well as using fronted adverbials to their sentences.

This term there will be a focus on handwriting and presentation skills. Will will be concentrating on developing the correct joins.

Maths

This term in maths we will be looking at place value through number recognition, adding 1, 10 and 100 more and comparing numbers to 1,000. As well as addition and subtraction where we will focus on using known facts, crossing 10s and 100s and problem solving.

Our multiplication focus this term will begin with recapping the two times table. Please support your child with learning their multiplication.

Science

In Science we are learning about Forces. Children will learn about a range of different forces and how they can be applied to objects. We will carry out investigations using gravity, friction and magnetism. The end of the term will focus on magnetism where children will explore whether objects are attracted to magnets or not.



History

In history, the children will be discovering all about Ancient Egypt. We will been exploring the importance of the River Nile, the purpose of the pyramids as well as the gods and afterlife.



Physical Education

With the sports coach this term the children will be doing tag rugby. With the class teacher the children will be practising throwing, batting and catching skills during rapid fire cricket sessions.

Computing

In computing this term, we will be looking closely at computer systems and will think about how networks and the internet share information.

Art

Year 3 will be learning how to add tonal value to their drawings. They will use this skill along with their knowledge of lines, shapes and form to create some beautiful artworks inspired by Valerie Hegarty.



RE Day

For our RE day this term we looking at why people pray with a focus on Sikhism.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

In PHSE we will be learning about 'Being me in my world'. We will set personal goals for ourselves, learn about our rights and responsibilities as well as understanding how our choices affect those around us.
