English

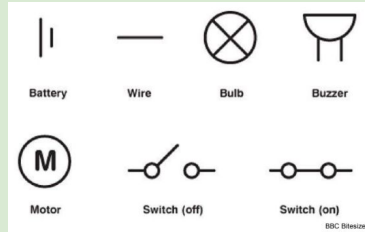

Science

This term, our learning will be based around electricity. We will investigate the variety of components needed to create a circuit as well as creating scientific diagrams to match these.



History

This term, pupils will be exploring World War 1. We will begin the topic looking at the causes of the war, the importance of alliances and research the key historical figures.

On the Wednesday 18th October, Year 6 will host a World War 1 experience day. Further details will be available nearer the time.

Design Technology

Our D.T learning this term will link with our history learning. We will be designing, making and evaluating our own gas masks!

Physical Education

This term, the pupils will be doing Tag Rugby, in line with the Rugby World Cup taking place in September and October - if you get a chance, try watching a game or two! The children will also be developing their coordination, batting and catching skills in Rapid Fire Cricket sessions!

Computing

This term, Computing learning will be linked our History learning of WW1. Pupils will explore the use of codes, the importance of passwords and research historical figures and their contributions towards computer science.

Art This term year 6 will be defining their drawing skills using their knowledge of lines, shape, form, tonal value, space and perspective. They will develop their use of orthogonal lines to help them sketch 2 point perspective cityscapes. Year 6 will be studying the fantastic artists such as Paul Nash and Stephen Wiltshire.



RE Day

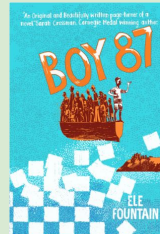
This term, our big question is 'What do religions say when life gets hard?'. Pupils will explore this big question with a focus on the Sikh religion.
