English

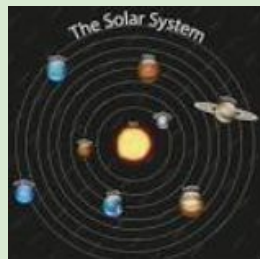
The first book we are going to read this term is "Coming to England." Based upon that book, the children will be writing a series of diary entries on the author's journey to a new country. As the term progresses, we will also be writing another narrative and learning to perform the poem "Twas the Night Before Christmas"

Maths

During the first term we will spend some time focussing again on times tables and ensuring the children are still firm in their knowledge. Within this we will be looking at number factors, multiples, prime, squared and cubed numbers. Towards the end of term, we will be looking at fractions; ordering, equivalent and mixed fractions in particular.

Science

Our first topic is Earth and Space. During this term the students will learn about the solar system and how earth rotates relative to the sun and other planets. They children will also have the opportunity to take part in a Space Experience Day this term. Details to follow.



History

Following from the Anglo Saxons, the children will learn about The Viking era. They will look at how the Vikings conquered different areas and different key figures from their communities. We are all looking forward to a performance on the Anglo Saxons and Vikings by the Hobgoblin Theatre Company on November 21st. All details of this visit are on Dojo.

Design Technology

This term, the children will be apply their knowledge learnt in Science from last term and creating Doodlers. Doodlers are drawing toys that include a fully functioning motor circuit.

Physical Education

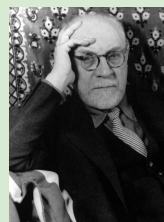

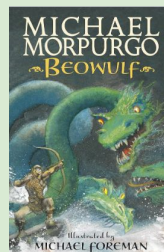
RE Day
