EYFS Learning Flyer - Term 2

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

Phonics - Literacy

We will be extending our understanding and consistency of key sounds surrounding Read Write Inc, as well as developing our blending and segmenting of decodable words too. With Read Write Inc, we are also developing our writing skills simultaneously, giving all children the opportunities to independently practice their mark-making and writing skills during their own free flow time. In Nursery, children will start listening and reciting some poems.

Maths

In Reception and Nursery, we explored what capacity is and how it can be measured using other objects, such as how many cups of water it took to fill up a bucket! We then move onto exploring simple patterns, recognising them in our environment and making them ourselves, before exploring numbers up to 3, the concept on one more and one less and subitising!

Understanding the World

This term, we are exploring the different festivals around the world that occur around this time of the year, such as Diwali, Christmas and many others! We will be discussing their similarities and differences and learning about the stories behind the celebrations. This will also help us learn more about our peers and the festivals they may celebrate at home that we do not!

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will talk about expressing our feelings. The children will be supported while they explore different techniques to encourage independent regulation of their emotions, and recognising emotions in their friends. As we look at celebrations and festivals this term, the children will also discuss the ways that we are similar and different to our friends, and celebrate the unique people and cultures that surround us!

Communication and Language

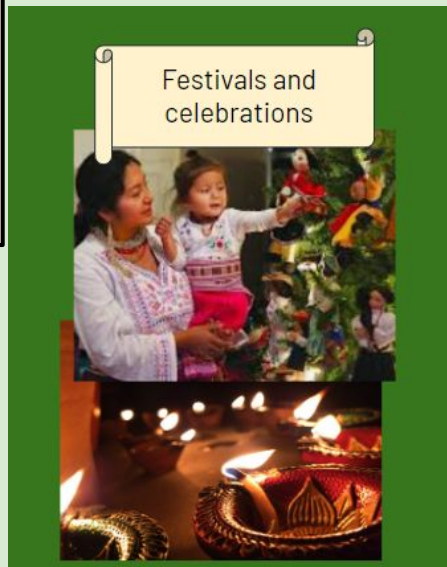
Nursery and Reception will continue to develop talk and conversations around themselves and the different festivals we are observing this term. Children will be encouraged to ask 'why' and 'how' questions and discuss them with their peers and adults.

RE Day

This term, our focus is on Christianity and the festivities around it.

Children will have lots of opportunities to explore, design and create artefacts related to different festivals we are observing this term. They will have opportunities to develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use. Children will be practising their songs and scripts for their Nativity!

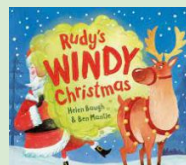
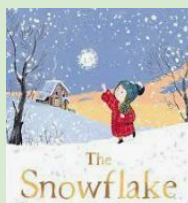
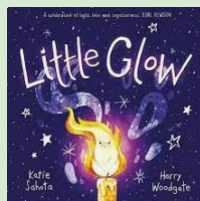
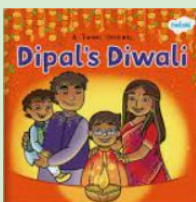


Physical Development
