This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

We will be starting the term by recapping our knowledge of adjectives and sentence writing to write a description of the Gruffalo.We will then create a set of instructions that will include command sentences and conjunctions.We will also be using our History learning about The Great Fire of London to write a diary entry as if we were actually there!

Maths

This term, we will be starting with the topic of place value. We will look at reading, writing and partitioning numbers up to 100. We will then move on to learning about addition and subtraction and we will use column method to add and take tens and ones from one and two digit numbers.

Science

In science this term, we will be exploring different materials. Our learning will include a number of investigations to discover the properties of a range of materials. We will be looking at how waterproof, how strong and how flexible different materials are and we will then use our knowledge to design our own boats.



History

Our History learning will be all about The Great Fire of London. We will be exploring when the fire happened, how it started and why the fire spread so quickly. We will also research who Samuel Pepys is and why his diary is so important.

Design Technology

Our DT learning is to create a chair for baby bear in the story 'Goldilocks and the three bears'. For this, we will be exploring a structures stability and strength.

Physical Education


In P.E this term the children will be taking part in cricket and basketball. The children's PE days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure that children wear their PE kit to school on these days.
