Year 5 Learning Flyer - Term 1

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

The first book we are going to read this term is "There's a boy in the Girl's Bathroom" by Louis Sachar. Based on what we read, we will then re-write the story from a different point of view. Following that we will continue to write stories in the form of recounts. As the term progresses we will move into Black History month and create biographies about key figures.

Maths

During the first term we will spend some time focussing again on times tables and ensuring the children are still firm in their knowledge. We will also be looking at the place value of numbers to 1,000,000 and the operations of addition and subtraction with increasingly larger numbers.

Science

Our first topic is Electricity. The children will be exploring how electricity works and demonstrating this on a basic circuit. We will also explore how electricity can be used as an alternative to fossil fuels.

History

We begin with the Anglo-Saxons from 410AD to 1066AD; learning about the history of the UK and how the Anglo-Saxons influenced our culture and shaped our history. We will dive into the everyday life of your average Anglo-Saxon family, Danelaw and the Battle of Hastings.

Design Technology

This term we will explore pop up books and look at the skills and techniques involved in making them.

Physical Education


