

# SOUTH BOROUGH PRIMARY SCHOOL EYFS Learning Flyer - Term 1

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

## Phonics - Literacy

In Reception, we will be starting our Read Write Inc phonics lessons, focusing on a new sound each day. As we learn new sounds, we'll also be discovering the letters that represent them, and how to form the letters when writing. During Free Flow time, the children will practice their mark making skills as well as show us what they already know!

In Nursery, children will start with listening and reciting some familiar nursery rhymes and songs.

## Understanding the World

The children in Reception and Nursery will discuss what makes them unique amongst their peers, but also what similarities they have too, as we look into our 'All About Me' topic. We will talk about who is in our family and all sorts of other interesting facts about their lives!

#### <u>Maths</u>

Reception will start the term by exploring patterns within nature and patterns made of 2-Dimensional shapes. We will also be matching and sorting objects together into categories, such as long stick and short sticks. We'll be practicing our 1:1 correspondence by comparing the amounts in our groups; 'Which group has the most amount of sticks?'.


Nursery will start the term matching and sorting objects into different categories.


# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As they start school, we'll be encouraging the children to be confident as they try new activities, manage their own needs and work cooperatively with their peers to form friendships. The children will start to identify when they need to put on a cardigan, or go to the toilet, or help themselves to a snack.


Communication and Language Reception and Nursery will have many opportunities to talk about themselves as well as listen to others, using new learnt language in their Free Flow time.

Expressive Arts and Design Reception and Nursery will experiment with a variety of artistic equipment this term, such as painting, crayons, pencils, chalks and junk modelling. The children will also consider which materials to use within their crafts too, such as glitter and feathers etc.









<u>Home Learning</u> Try to read and watch phonics videos and get your reading record signed to have your read counted! Please talk to your child about their feelings in regards to starting Reception.

#### **RE Day**

This term on R.E day we'll be discussing which stories are special to us and why, focussing on the key religion, Sikhism.

#### **Physical Development**

The children will be enjoying exploring their new outside area this term and will begin to negotiate their new space and navigate obstacles. The children will hone their gross motor skills through the bikes and scooters, and their fine motors skills through delicate tasks such as cutting with scissors or gripping a pencil.
