

SOUTH BOROUGH PRIMARY SCHOOL Year 2 Learning Flyer - Term 2

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

We will be starting the term writing an information text that contains conjunctions about Dragons. We will then move on to retelling the tale of Little Red Riding Hood. This will allow the children to explore using exclamation and question sentences. Towards the end of the term, we will be writing a Christmas noem

We are having a big focus on handwriting this term. Please continue to practice letter formation at home.

Maths

This term, we will be learning about addition and subtraction. The children will be using column method to add and subtract 2 digit numbers up to 100 and they will then applying this knowledge to word problems. Later in the term, we will be moving on to look at 2D and 3D shapes, identifying them by looking at their properties.

Science

In science this term, we will be continuing to explore different materials. We will look at the different properties of each material and talk about why certain materials are more suitable than others for different objects.

Physical Education

In P.E this term the children will be taking part in cricket and basketball. The children's PE days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure that children wear their PE kit to school on these days.

History

This term we are looking at local history and will therefore be studying Maidstone! We will look at how Maidstone has changed over the years, why Maidstone's coat of arms is important and even taking a look at how Cobtree Manor used to be Maidstone Zoo.

Design Technology

Our DT learning this term is based around sewing. The children will get the chance to design their own pouch, practise some simple stitches and then sew their pouch using their own design.





Computing

In computing this term, we will be looking at algorithms. The children will practise using the computers and creating their own algorithm to control an online game.

<u>Art</u>

This term year 2 will be studying the artists Piet Mondrian and Wassily Kandinsky.

They will be looking at the colour wheel and learning how to mix and use colours.

<u>Music</u>

In music this term, we will be performing the song 'I want to play in a band'. The children will take part in some rhythm games and will learn and perform the song.

RE Day

This terms RE day will be based on Christianity. We will explore Christian beliefs and will learn about how christians show their faith.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

In PSHE this term, our topic will be celebrating difference. We will discuss the differences and similarities between the children and will talk about how we can celebrate these differences.
