This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

To begin the term, we will be writing a narrative to tell the story of 'The Alchemist's Letter'. Later in the term we will create a diary entry and a character description. Through these we will explore the setting and characters, understand the features of a narrative and expand our vocabulary further.

Maths

At the start of this term, we will be recapping multiplication and division, recognising multiples of 10, 100 and 1000. Later in the term our learning will be focused on converting, adding and subtracting fractions. We will be building on knowledge learnt in year 4.

Science

In Science this term, we will be researching evolution and inheritance, exploring variation and how living things adapt and evolve to survive.

Physical Education

During outdoor PE sessions this term the children will be learning to play football. With our Team Theme coach, the children will be learning dance by creating movements and patterns with their body.

Computing

The children will be learning how to stay safe online as well as programming music using Scratch!

Art

This term year 5 will be deepening their understanding of colour theory with more complex colour combinations, they will apply their knowledge to their artwork and study the polychromatic works of Pablo Picasso and Henri Matisse!

Geography

In geography we will be learning about mountains. We will be learning about mountain ranges from across the world and how they are formed with a focus on North and South America.

RE Day

This term we will be exploring the question, "If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?"

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

In Jigsaw our theme is 'Celebrating Differences'. We look at understanding cultural differences and explain the types of bullying that relate to this. We will use our Zones of Regulation lessons to help in regulating our feelings.
