This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term in reading, we will be focusing on space. The children will look at a number of stories set in space as well as some non-fiction texts. In writing, the children will write for a number of different purposes starting by writing a short story based upon the book 'Beegu'. The children will also be completing a piece of writing later in the term based upon the book 'Voices in the Park' as part of a whole school writing project.

Maths

At the start of the term we will be consolidating our learning on multiplication and division by looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times table facts. We will be able to split shapes and numbers into halves, quarters and thirds. This will include exploring both unit and non unit fractions. Please continue to encourage your child to access Mathletics and TTRS.

Science

This term the children will be learning about plants. The children will get the chance to plant their own seed and watch it grow. We will be trying to prove that plants require water, light and a suitable temperature to grow throughout the term.



Geography

During geography lessons, we will be exploring weather patterns and terrain in the United Kingdom and the two polar regions. We will then discuss explorers who played a role in discovering both the North and South pole.

Art

Music

This term year 2 are learning about form, we will be exploring the phenomenal art works by Calvin Nicholls and using cardboard to create some of our own fantastic animal creations!

Physical Education

This term, we will be trying netball and tennis. The children will be focusing on hand eye coordination and considering the importance of working in a team.

Computing

In computing this term, we will be looking at ways of handling data. The children will read and input data to identify whether planets are habitable.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

During PSHE, our theme is 'Healthy Me'. We will look at how to keep our bodies and minds healthy. We will also look at the importance of medicine safety and eating healthily. The children will also explore the importance of inner resilience.




RE Day


