This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

<u>English</u>

This term, we will be reading "The Boy in the Tower" by Polly Ho-Yen; a book about the struggles of a young boy living in a world where plants have started to take over. We will also Joseph Coelho's poetry book, "Overheard in the Tower Block"; a series of poems that form one continuous tale of a boy's life from childhood to adolescence to adulthood.

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be continuing to focus on boosting times tables knowledge through daily practice. We will be continuing on with our work on fractions, decimals and percentages throughout this term. This will involve finding fractions of amounts and solving problem solving questions using their knowledge of times tables and their interactions with fractions. This will logically move us into statistics towards the end of the term.

<u>Science</u>

In Term 4 we will be exploring more about the aspects of light and how light works in relation to different types of materials. We will also have an opportunity to explore light using different scientific equipment such as prisms.



Geography

For our second term of Geography learning this year, children will be taking a close look at the continent of South America. They will be learning about the characteristics of the rainforest and the different environmental factors that affect this continent.
