This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term, the pupils will be writing a balanced argument about William Shakespeare's Macbeth. They will be answering the question "Was Lady Macbeth good or evil?".

Maths

This term we will continue our learning about decimals, whilst introducing the link between decimals, fractions and percentages. We will continue to regularly revisit the four operations throughout our arithmetic Friday lessons. Later in the term, we will recap area, perimeter and volume building on Year 5 learning.

The children will continue to receive home learning with the use of their arithmetic books.

Science

Building on last term's learning, children will continue to explore Light. Developing an understanding of how we see things and explore why shadows have the same shapes as the object casting them. During this time, the children will carry out investigations using scientific equipment. Children will then have the opportunity to showcase their understanding when answering the Key Assessment Question: **How does light allow us to see objects? Prove it.**

Geography

This term, Year 6 will continue studying the United Kingdom. Our focus will be on describing and understanding the key aspects of human geography which will include a study on migration and settlement.

Music

This term we will explore the genre Jazz, children will listen and appraise different Jazz artists. Children will also learn to play and compose their own Jazz music.

Physical Education

During outdoor PE sessions the children will be learning the skills of Tennis, including simple serve and rally techniques, and how to score. Children will also continue to develop their Lacrosse skills with our Team Theme coach.

Computing

In computing we will be delving into data handling, we will explore the use of barcodes and QR codes and how to use them. Children will also analyse real life data.

Art

Year 6 will be exploring the delicious world of Pop artist Wayne Thiebaud this term, we will sketch geometric form and turn them into pies, cake and icecreams then use clay to realise our designs!

Term 4's big question will be:

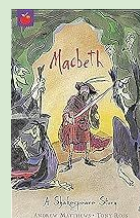
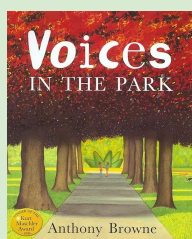
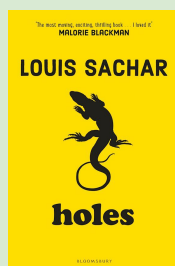
Is it better to express your beliefs in art and architecture or in charity and generosity?
