

SOUTH BOROUGH PRIMARY SCHOOL Year 5 Learning Flyer - Term 5

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term, we will be looking at multiple different writing outcomes. Students will first write a newspaper article outlining and celebrating the historic win of Maidstone Utd vs Ipswich. Students will need to utilise a formal tone and write in the style of a real journalist. Following this, students will also be writing the continuation of a chapter and writing a narrative poem in the classic style of "The Highwayman".

Maths

This term we will be covering a variety of topics. We will start by looking at line graphs and bar charts to expand our understanding of statistics.

How can you help at home?

Premier League Stats: Is your child a football fan? Check the Premier League website or newspaper for recent match statistics. Work together to create a bar chart showing the number of goals scored by different teams. Discuss which team scored the most and least, and calculate the average goals per game.

Science

In Term 5 we will be learning about the human body systems and how they work. We will look into the circulatory system and how humans and animals get energy from food. We will also learn about how our choices and our age can impact how our bodies work.



Geography

In geography this term, students will be learning about the world around them. We will look in depth at maps and how they are created by cartographers using lines of latitude and longitude.

Spanish

In Spanish, the students will be learning all about las ropas (clothes). The students will be learning this through interactive conversations and songs!

Physical Education

This term we will be focussing on tri-golf. Tri-golf is a more active and engaging version of golf (more suited to a playground and school setting). Tri-golf enables students to practice and learn the golf fundamentals in a safe environment practicing and measuring their swing.

Computing

Year 5 will be looking at stop motion using cameras. The students will plan, edit and create a stop motion animation from start to finish.

<u>Αrτ</u>

Year 5 will be learning about printmaking and creating lino style cut prints.

They will be exploring the Norwegian artist Edvard Munch and his use of lines, colour and composition to help them create their own Munch style masterpieces.



RE Day - Buddhism

In Term 5 we will be learning about Buddhism on a dedicated RE day towards the end of term.
