Year 2 Learning Flyer - Term 3

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

At the start of this term we will be creating some writing around the topic of animals. We will be writing a letter based upon the book Dear Greenpeace and will then write a set of instructions explaining how to make an animal model from clay. We will finish this term by writing a recount. In reading we will be focusing on increasing our vocabulary as well as continuing to work on inference skills. Please continue to practise letter formation at home.

Maths


We will be starting the term by looking at shapes. We will describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes as well as looking at symmetry. We will then move on to looking at multiplication and division. We will be learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables as well as solving problems. Keep an eye out for the children's TTRS logins so that the children practise this skill at home!

Science

In Science, we are learning about animals including human. Our key assessment question is 'How are the basic needs of animals and humans similar/dissimilar?' To help us investigate this we will be looking at the life cycle of animals, what a balanced diet is and why hygiene and exercise is important.

Geography

This term we are looking at 'our wonderful world'. The children will learn the names of all continents and oceans. We will also be learning how the continents have shifted over time.



Physical Education

In P.E this term the children will be taking part in gymnastics and football. The children's PE days are **Monday and Friday**. Please ensure that children wear their PE kit to school on these days.

Computing

Our computing this term will be focussed on word processing. The children will practise their keyboard skills and will explore adding text and images to a document.

Art

This term Year 2 will be learning about texture and materials, they will create a collage and study the fabulous French artist Henri Rousseau.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

In Jigsaw our theme is Dreams and Goals. We will be celebrating our achievement and recognising our learning strengths. We will also be spending some time this term thinking about teamwork and why it is important to consider not only our feelings but other people's.

RE Day

This term the RE day will answer the question how and why do we celebrate special times? The religion that we are going to look at this term is Hinduism.
