Year 3 Learning Flyer - Term 4

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term, we will be linking our learning in geography to help us create our own persuasive leaflet about Greece. We will explore and use persuasive techniques to encourage the reader to make their own trip to this beautiful country.

For World Book Day and our Whole School Writing project, we will be joining the school in creating a piece of descriptive writing about Anthony Browne's *Voices in the Park*.

Maths

The children will begin the term building on their understanding of measurements. We will recap metres, centimeters and millimeters, understand the relationship between the different measurements and use our knowledge of addition and subtraction to calculate measurements. Later in the term, we will be learning about fractions. We will explore and compare equivalent fractions.

In our daily multiplication practise we will be focusing on a quick recall of the three times table.

Physical Education

With the coach the children will be working on movement and understanding the rules of Lacrosse. With class teachers they will be focusing on a range of different strokes and skills in tennis.

Design Technology

This term, the children will be exploring 3D shapes and using nets to create a range of shapes which they will then use to help them design and build a castle and understand how the different shapes support their creation.

Geography

We are continuing to focus on Europe. However, this term we will be focusing on human geography. We will be looking at different cities across Europe and the time zones, famous landmarks and what makes something a tourist destination.

Science

In Science, we are continuing our learning of plants. We will investigate the different requirements for plant life, understand how water is transported and discover the life cycle of plants and the importance of pollination and seed dispersal.

Computing

In computing, the children will begin the term recapping the importance of staying safe online. They will then think about the different components of a laptop and create an information presentation.

This term year 3 will be learning about the contemporary Cubist artist Melissa Bollen. They will explore visual form and create some amazing relief sculptures from their ideas!

This term, the children will be thinking about improvisation and, using a range of instruments, will have fun and be creative.

RE Day

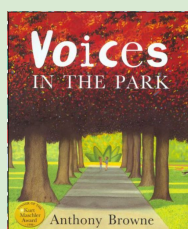
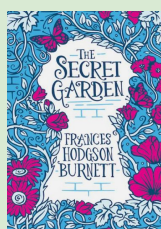
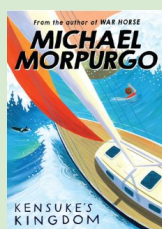
Our RE day will take place on Friday 22nd March. Our focus for this day will be Islam and thinking about what we can learn about from religions.
