Year 2 Learning Flyer - Term 6

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term we will be writing a letter, a diary entry and a poem. These pieces of writing will be inspired by the texts we will look at in our reading which include Dear Greenpeace and the Little People, Big Dreams books. Within their writing, the children will be encouraged to focus on making sure all of their writing makes sense, is neat and is spelt phonetically before they try to extend their sentences.

How can you help? Practise joining letters with your child. Read for 10 minutes with your child each night.

Maths

In Maths, we will be beginning the term by continuing to tell the time to 5 minutes. We will then be looking at measurement and considering the length and height of objects as well as their weight. We will also be learning statistics and looking at tallies and pictograms.

How can you help? Encourage your child to play numbots regularly. Show your child the time on an analogue clock regularly.

Science

Our science topic this term is 'Living things and their environments'. We will look at the differences between living, dead and never been alive. We will also look at how most living things live in a habitat or microhabitat and how this is adapted to meet their needs.



History

This term we will be looking at 'Powerful voices' this term. The children will look at a number of significant people both from history and in the modern world. This will include Gandhi, Martin Luther King, Greta Thunberg and David Attenborough. They will explore why these people are seen as important and will learn about their accomplishments.

Computing

In computing this term, we will be programming using scratch jr. We will use the programme to create an animation. The children will plan and use their own algorithm.

How can you help? Scratch Jr is available as a free app so the children can continue to practise applying their skills at home.



Art

This term year 2 will be studying the contemporary artist Sarah Morris and her use of patterns in art. The children will also be applying their knowledge of the elements of art to create some magnificent end of year pieces.

DT

This term, the children will take part in a DT day. They will spend the day designing and making a moving picture using sliders and levers.

Music

The children will be learning about exploring the song 'Yellow Submarine' by the Beatles.

RE Day

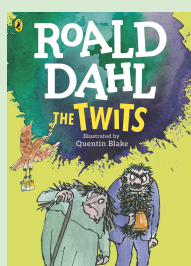
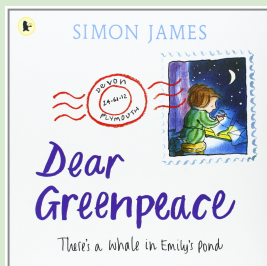
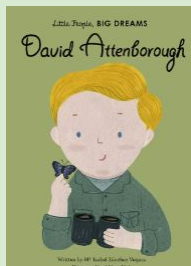
Our religion this term is Humanism. Our key question is What makes some places sacred?
