Year 1 Learning Flyer - Term 3

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English In English this term, Year 1 will be exploring different types of text. We will be looking at fables and focusing on 'The Lion and the Mouse'. The children will learn the features of a fable and understand that fables teach us a moral. We will also be learning about 'Chinese New Year' which is the year of the Snake! Towards the end of term we will be writing animal fact files and receive a visit from the 'Creepy claws' man.

How can you help? Share some fables with your child and talk about the moral of the story.



Math This term your children will be learning that numbers like 11-20 are made up of 1 ten and some ones (e.g., 12 is 1 ten and 2 ones). They will use number lines to 20 to help them compare, order, and estimate numbers. They will learn to identify the number that is one more or one less than any number between 11 and 20. Later in the term, we will focus on **addition and subtraction**. They will learn to add by counting on, use number bonds (like $10 + 5 = 15$), and learn about doubles (like $2 + 2 = 4$). They will learn to subtract by counting back, use number bonds to find the difference between numbers, and subtract ones from numbers within 20.

How can you help? Play games that involve counting; counting steps while walking, cars passing by, or objects in the home.

Science

In Science this term, Year 1 will be learning about **animals including humans**. This will involve being able to recognise a variety of animals, where they live and what they eat. We are very lucky as we will be having a visitor coming in with some animals for us to meet on Thursday the 6th of February. It is going to be very exciting!

How you can support at home: Research various different animals, focusing on the features of mammals, fish and birds.



History

For history this term, Year 1 will be learning all about **kings, queens and leaders**. We will learn about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements, events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally and changes within living memory (the coronation of Elizabeth II).

How you can support at home: Find out about different kings and queens that ruled our country. Take a visit to a castle. Allow your child to dress up and be king or queen for the day.

Computing

Year 1 will be learning more about 'online safety', in addition to 'exploring new devices' such as Beebots. We will learn 'how to instruct/program a Beebot to maneuver'.

How can you help?

Discuss with your child about 'how' and 'why' keeping safe online is paramount..



Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

'Dreams and Goals'

In Jigsaw this term, we will be learning how to set ourselves goals, identify successes and how we feel about our achievements. We will also be celebrating those successes, while working as a team when tackling challenges, identifying and overcoming any obstacles.



Physical Education

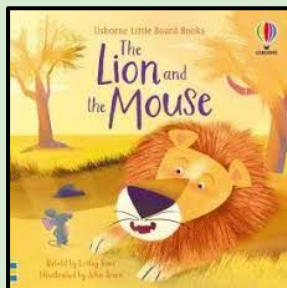

P.E for Year 1 will take place every Tuesday and Friday this term.

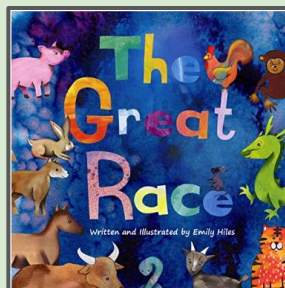
Art
