| English This term, our writing will be inspired by Kate DiCamillo's enchanting novel, <i>The Miraculous Adventures of Edward</i> <i>Tulane</i> . We'll step into Edward's paws and create diary entries, capturing his experiences and emotions. Later in the term, we'll explore and write our own Haiku poetry, finding further inspiration within the pages of our class book. We will continue to focus on spelling skills, understanding how different letter combinations can represent the same sounds. How can you help? Spelling Shed and Rollama are great resources to support spelling, punctuation & grammar. | | MathsThis term in maths, we will be finishing off learning about measurements in mass and capacity. We will be looking at equivalent measurements, taking accurate measurements as well as adding and subtracting different measurements. We will also continue to look at fractions. The children will learn how to add and subtract fractions, partitioning the whole and understanding how to find fractions of amounts. How can you help? Encourage your child to play TRS for a few minutes, 4-5 times a week. | | |
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| Science This term we are looking at Rocks. We will develop an understanding of what a rock is. We will be looking at how rocks are formed. As well as how geologists classify and sort different rocks. Ultimately answering the question 'What can rocks tell geologists about our planet?' How can you help?
