Year 3 Learning Flyer - *Term 5*

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term, our writing will be inspired by Kate DiCamillo's enchanting novel, *The Miraculous Adventures of Edward Tulane*. We'll step into Edward's paws and create diary entries, capturing his experiences and emotions. Later in the term, we'll explore and write our own Haiku poetry, finding further inspiration within the pages of our class book.

We will continue to focus on spelling skills, understanding how different letter combinations can represent the same sounds.

How can you help? [Spelling Shed](#) and [Rollama](#) are great resources to support spelling, punctuation & grammar.

Maths

This term in maths, we will be finishing off learning about measurements in mass and capacity. We will be looking at equivalent measurements, taking accurate measurements as well as adding and subtracting different measurements. We will also continue to look at fractions. The children will learn how to add and subtract fractions, partitioning the whole and understanding how to find fractions of amounts.

How can you help? Encourage your child to play [TTRS](#) for a few minutes, 4-5 times a week.

Science

This term we are looking at Rocks. We will develop an understanding of what a rock is. We will be looking at how rocks are formed. As well as how geologists classify and sort different rocks. Ultimately answering the question 'What can rocks tell geologists about our planet?' **How can you help?** When out and about help the children to find interesting rocks and try to identify the type of rock.

History

Over the term, we will be understanding the relationship between the monarchy, church and the people during the Middle Ages. We will begin to understand some of the changes that took place during this period such as Henry II's legal reforms and the sealing of the Magna Carta

Physical Education

This term children will be developing skills, knowledge and tactics based on different sports as well as teamwork and leadership. Coaches are teaching hockey while class teachers are delivering Paralympic sports including Boccia, seated volleyball and Goalball..

Geography

In geography we will be focusing on Rivers. We will be understanding what a river is. We will look at important rivers around the world and their significance to locals.

How can you help? Take a walk along the River Medway and discuss joining streams/ivers and different uses you see.

Computing

We will begin the term by recapping internet safety before moving onto to explore photos and videos. We will be thinking about how we can add text, transitions and sounds to these.

Art

This term year 3 will be learning about printmaking. They will be making multiple prints in the style of the American Pop artist Andy Warhol, they will use their knowledge of colour theory and repeat prints to recreate Warhol style masterpieces!

DT

Our focus this term is to understand where food comes from and then using their learning to help create a seasonal food tart.

How can you help?

Involve your child in cooking at home so they can gain confidence in using knives and peelers when preparing food.

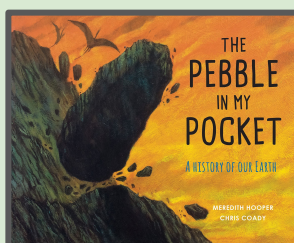
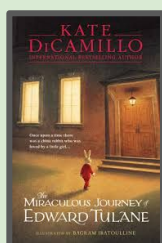
Spanish
