This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

# **English**

This term, we will be writing part of a narrative inspired by the film WALL-E which will allow the children to continue to develop their story writing skills and practise using speech to make their writing even more interesting.

We will be focus on handwriting, understanding how different letter combinations can represent the same sounds. How can you help? Spelling Shed and Rollama are great resources to support spelling, punctuation & grammar.

# **Maths**

This term in maths, we are covering time, money and shape. We will be learning how to add and subtract amounts of money and how to work out change. We will be adding to the pupils knowledge of telling the time and looking at what will the time be after set periods. In shape we will recap 2D and 3D shapes as well as learning about angles.

**How can you help?** Encourage your child to play <u>TTRS</u> for a few minutes, 4-5 times a week.


# Science

This term we are thinking about forces and magnets and understanding how forces change the movement of an object. We will then explore magnets and how these can attract or repel certain metals.

How can you help? Watch these lessons to give your child a deeper understanding of the topic

# History

Over the term, we are going to be learning about the War of the Roses and how this civil war was fought between two rival branches of the royal House of Plantagenet.

# **Physical Education**

With class teachers the pupils will be focusing on a variety of athletic events including sprinting, throwing and jumping. Team Theme coaches will be providing sessions on four square and an introduction to Tag American Football with a focus on developing team work.

# Geography

Our focus for the term in geography is India and China. We will be exploring these diverse landscapes. Looking at human geography including famous landmarks and physical geography such as climates, biomes and rivers.

# Computing

This term we will be focusing on spreadsheets to understand why and how they are used. We will create our own spreadsheets which will enable the children to sort, filter and interpret data.

Year 3 will be using their cutting and drawing skills to create Japanese Notan art with patterns! The children will be using their elements of art knowledge gained throughout the year to complete some amazing artworks.

This term we are going to be having a DT day with the aim of producing our own bread. We will be exploring the techniques, ingredients and processes behind bread making before creating and baking some bread of our own.

### Music

Night on the Bare Mountain by Mussorgsky will be our focus for music. The pupils will be listening to the different motifs to understand their impact and then creating their own piece of suspenseful music.

# Personal, Social, Health and **Economic Education (PSHE)**

We will be exploring the topic 'Changing Me'. This will include considering that every one of us is unique and special, as well as learning about the changes we see in ourselves and others. Later in the term the children will explore what they are looking forward to next year.
