## Year 1 Learning Flyer - Term 6

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

### English

Year 1 will explore a traditional story called 'The Three Little Pigs' and then not so traditional ones; 'Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig' in English lessons. Children will retell stories, write narratives, and fact files on wolves or pigs. They'll also write letters, diary entries (from a pig's or wolf's view), design a "wanted" poster and compose a wolf poem. They'll learn and use adjectives, suffixes (-ed, -ing, -er, -est), plurals, connectives and conjunctions to improve their writing.

### Design and Technology (DT)

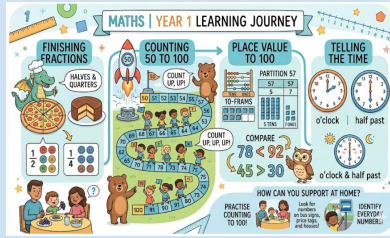
This term in DT, Year 1 will become young engineers as they design, make, and evaluate their own stable vehicles using wheels, axles, and strong materials!

### Science

In Science this term, our topic is the human body. The children will be learning about their 5 senses. They will identify their senses and will start to understand how we see and hear before exploring some sensory impairments.

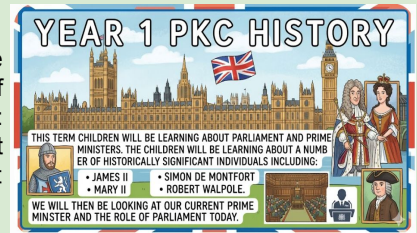
#### How can you support at Home?

Discuss which senses you are using as you go about your daily life.



**Maths** This term Year 1 will learn about fractions before focusing on counting between 50 and 100. We will look at how to partition numbers into tens and ones and compare numbers to 100. At the end of term, we will also be covering time and the children will learn to tell the time to o'clock and half past. **How can you support at home?** Encourage your child to identify numbers that are in their day to day life. Practise counting with your child up to 100.

**History** This term children will be learning about parliament and prime ministers. The children will be learning about a number of historically significant individuals including: James II, Mary II, Simon de Montfort and Robert Walpole. We will then be looking at our current prime minister and the role of parliament today.



### Computing

This term Year 1 will be starting to use the desktop computers.

They will be taught about the different parts of a computer and will be able to identify the input devices.

They will then practise logging in and using the mouse and keyboard to move the cursor and type.

### Physical Education (P.E)

We will be focusing on two topics, Tag Rugby and Athletics.

**Tag Rugby:** we'll develop our teamwork, communication & strategic thinking skills. We'll learn how to evade defenders, pass effectively and work together to score tries; in a non-contact environment.

**Athletics:** we'll be covering a range of disciplines, including running, jumping and throwing. We will have the opportunity to improve our speed, strength, agility and coordination, while also learning about different athletic techniques.

**P.E for Year 1 will continue to take place every Tuesday this term.**

### Art

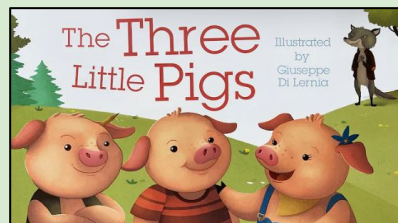
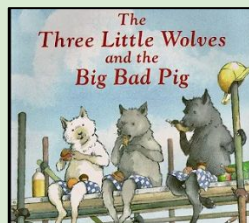
Year 1 will be learning about patterns this term and the African artist Esther Mahlangu. They will also be using their knowledge of the elements of art to create some end of year masterpieces!
