Year 1 Learning Flyer - Term 3

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

Year 1 will start this term by retelling stories. We will continue to focus on using our phonics sounds in our writing as well as ensuring that sentences are written in past tense and have capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Later in the term, the children will be writing recounts based on some exciting activities that will link to our afternoon learning.

How can you help? Read for 10 minutes each night with your child and ask the children to retell the story to you when they have finished reading.

Math Year 1 will be learning that numbers between 10 and 20 are made up of 1 ten and some ones (e.g., 12 is 1 ten and 2 ones). They will use number lines to 20 to help them compare, order, and estimate numbers. They will learn to identify the number that is one more or one less than numbers between 10 and 20. Later, we will focus on **addition and subtraction**: They will learn to add by counting on, use number bonds (e.g. $10 + 5 = 15$), learn about doubles (e.g. $2 + 2 = 4$), subtracting by counting back, use number bonds to find the difference between numbers. **How can you help?** Play counting games; count steps whilst walking, or cars that pass by.

Science

This term, Year 1 will become junior meteorologists as they investigate the four seasons and our changing weather, learning how to identify clouds, use scientific tools to record data, and create weather graphs to track their findings, just like professional weather forecasters.



Geography

This term, we will be learning about the United Kingdom. The children will learn which countries make up the UK and will then explore some of the differences between these four countries, including both cultural and physical differences.

How can you help? Talk about which countries in the United Kingdom they may have been to and what the country is like.

We will continue our daily learning of phonics.





Physical Education (P.E)

During P.E we will be focusing on two topics, **gymnastics** (indoors) and **football** (outdoors). This will help the children to improve their gross motor skills, coordination and balance.
