



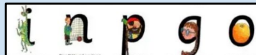

## EYFS Learning Flyer - *Term 1*

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.



### Phonics & Literacy



**Nursery**, children will build foundational listening skills by exploring environmental sounds, focusing on noises heard at school, outdoors, at home, and animal sounds.

**Reception**, children will begin daily Read Write Inc (RWI) phonics lessons, introducing a new sound each day (Please practise these sounds with your child everyday). Alongside learning these sounds, they will discover the letters that represent them and practise forming the letters in writing.

### Understanding the World

The children in Nursery and Reception will start to discuss their families, talking about the similarities and differences between themselves and their friends. As we look at our 'all about me' topic, we'll also talk about what we look like, where we live and who is around us. **How can you help?**

### Communication and Language

Nursery and Reception will have many opportunities to talk about themselves and be a good listener. We will encourage them to greet others with a "good morning" or "hello".

**How can you help?** Ask your child(ren) questions about their day, encourage them to speak in full sentences.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Nursery and Reception will experiment with a variety of artistic equipment this term, such as painting, crayons, pencils, chalks and junk modelling. The children will also consider which materials to use within their crafts too, such as glitter and feathers etc.

**How can you help?** Encourage your children to use a range of equipment to create Artwork at home.

### RE Day

In RE we will be looking at similarities and differences between our cultures and different cultures around the world, including what stories, events and people are special to us.

**How You Can Help at Home:** Share family photos, talk about special traditions or celebrations your family enjoys, and read storybooks together that feature diverse characters, cultures, and festivals!

### Maths

**Nursery, Counting & Quantities:** counting real objects, singing counting songs, understanding 'more, a lot, same'.

**Patterns:** Spotting/copying simple two-color or two-object repeating patterns.

**Shapes & Space:** investigating 2D and 3D shapes during block play and comparing sizes (*big, small, heavy, light*).

**Reception, Subitising:** spotting small amounts without counting (e.g. dots on a die or fingers held up).

**Number Composition:** seeing how numbers break down into smaller parts (e.g. knowing 5 can be made of 3 and 2).

**Spatial Reasoning:** exploring shapes, measuring capacity (full/empty), and creating complex repeating patterns.

**How You Can Help?:** count everyday items together (like setting plates for dinner), roll dice during board games, and spot patterns on your walk to school!

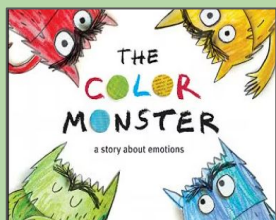
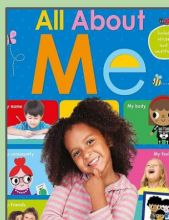
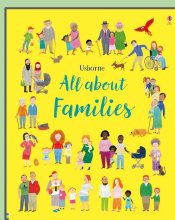
### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As they start school, we'll be encouraging the children to be confident as they try new activities, manage their own needs and work cooperatively with their peers to form friendships. The children will start to identify when they need to put on a cardigan (chilly), or go to the toilet (self-care), or help themselves to a snack (hungry). **How can you help?** Click [here](#) to watch a video about 'Pantosaur' and talk with your child about why pants are private.

### Physical Development

The children will be enjoying exploring activities in the outdoor area. They will begin to negotiate their new space and navigate obstacles. The children will develop their gross motor skills through climbing, riding bikes and scooters, and develop their fine motor skills through delicate tasks such as threading, cutting with scissors or gripping mark making materials. **How can you help?** Click [here](#) to try a fun activity to get moving about!

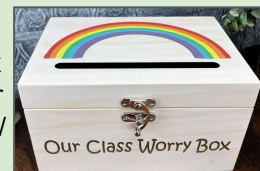
