Year 3 Learning Flyer - Term 4

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

As part of our World Book Day celebrations and along with the whole school, we are using *The Invisible* by to inspire our writing. We will be rewriting the story using sophisticated language as well as dialogue to create our own version.

How can you help? Practise writing speech using the rules of speech, watch the first part of [this lesson](#) to help recall the different rules.

Later in the term, we will be using our history lessons to help us write a description of the beast Grendell from the myth Beowulf.

Maths

This term in maths, we will be learning about measurements in length, mass and capacity. We will be looking at equivalent measurements, taking accurate measurements as well as adding and subtracting different measurements. We will also begin to look at fractions. The children will learn unit and non unit fractions, equivalent fractions and understanding how fractions make a whole. **How can you help?** Ask children to help with measurements around the house. Can they help with meal preparation to improve their accurate measurement skills or add together different amounts.

Science

This term we are looking at forces and magnetism. We will be exploring gravity and magnetism in depth conducting a range of experiments to see the effects of these forces and recording our results. These results will help us to improve our understanding and develop scientific reasoning.

History

In history, the children will continue to build upon their understanding of history in Britain by learning about the Viking invasion. They will find out about how these expert shipbuilders raided, traded and eventually settled in Britain.

How can you help?

Physical Education

With class teachers and sports coaches children will be developing skills, knowledge and tactics based on different sports as well as teamwork and leadership. Coaches are teaching tennis while class teachers are delivering hockey sessions.

Geography

In geography we will be focusing on South West England. We will be learning about the different counties, the climate and why tourists may want to visit this region. **How can you help?** Help your child understand the difference between weather and climate [here](#).



Art

Year 3 this term will be developing their drawing skills, knowledge of form and the use of value in art. They will study the artist Melissa Bolen and hone their bas-relief sculpture abilities.

DT

The children are becoming young bakers by learning the science of how yeast makes dough rise and how wheat and dairy are transformed into everyday staples. They are developing their cooking skills as they bake, slice, and prepare their own fresh bread.

Music




This term, the children are exploring how composer Benjamin Britten used the different sections of the orchestra to mimic the sounds and moods of the sea.
