Year 1 Learning Flyer - *Term 1*

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

In English this term, Year 1 will be practising letter formation, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to create sentences. In Phonics, we will continue to practise and learn single sounds, digraphs and trigraphs. We will use Fred talk and Fred fingers when reading and writing.

How can you help? Read every night with your child for 10 minutes and practise the phonics sounds.

Maths

This term, Year 1 will be learning about Number - Place Value (within 10). To begin with we will be looking at sorting objects and representing numbers in different ways. We will then practise counting forwards and backwards within 10.

How can you help? Make a game of matching objects, pair socks or sort groups of animals and insects by the number of legs they have.

Science

In Science this term, Year 1 will be learning about materials, such as wood, metal, plastic and glass. We will sort and classify objects according to the material they are made from. We will also learn about the properties of materials, such as absorbency, flexibility and transparency. Throughout the year, we will be studying the seasons. We will observe Autumnal changes over time and gather and record data about leaves.

How can you help? Encourage your child to identify the materials that objects around the house are made from and talk about why this material is suitable for its purpose.

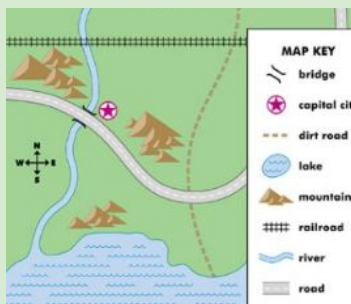
Geography

This term, Year 1 will begin their first geography unit, focusing on maps and aerial views. Children will learn to: Understand what things look like from above (aerial perspective). Recognise symbols and use a key to read maps. Differentiate between physical (natural) and human (man-made) features. Use the four point compass and simple positional language. They will apply these skills by looking at simple routes on a map of a familiar location.

How can you help? Draw a simple map of your house or garden and have your child add symbols for different objects. Use a simple park map on a family outing, let your child help follow the route.

Design Technology Day

In DT, we will make bean dip and tzatziki with vegetable sticks. We'll learn that fruits and vegetables provide nutrients and some are better raw, also revisiting sweet and savoury tastes. They'll learn to cut and chop with a knife using bridge and claw techniques, practising in session one before making the dips in session two. They'll taste and evaluate their creations.



Physical Education

During P.E we will be focusing on two topics, basketball and rapid fire cricket. This will help the children to improve their gross motor skills by helping them to learn how to catch, throw and aim. **P.E for Year 1 will be every Tuesday.**

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

We will be learning about resilience this term. We will learn what being resilient means and how to cope with our emotions to allow us to experience success.

R.E

In RE this term we will be looking at a number of religions. We will look at sacred places and sacred texts. We will then be discussing how different religions celebrate their special days

Music

In Music this term the children will be learning about beats and rhythms. They will have a go at making their own music to a beat.

Computing

This term we will be learning about the hardware of a computer and what the inputs and outputs are. We will practise using the school chromebooks to build our computer skills.

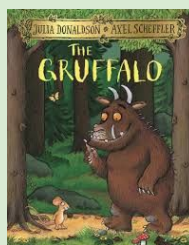
Art

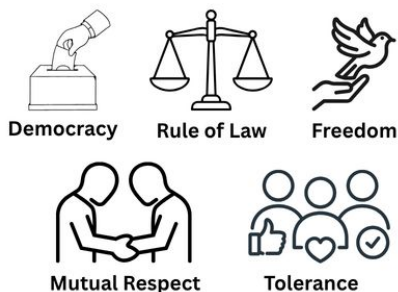
