EYFS Learning Flyer - Term 6

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

Phonics - Literacy

Children in Reception will continue to be encouraged to read words with special friends they have learnt and words with 4 sounds. They will be use the phonics they know to spell words that they think of in short phrases and sentences. Children will be challenged to use red words such as 'the', 'my' and 'we'. In Nursery, children will continue to practise their name writing and retelling stories/ nursery rhymes.

How can you help? [Word Time Fun with Elly](#) In Nursery we will continue to work on writing our names, and the letters and sounds that are in them, please also continue to practise at home.

Understanding the World

This term our Reception and Nursery children will be exploring the wonderful theme of growing and changing. We will be observing the natural world firsthand by investigating fascinating life cycles, such as how a tiny egg transforms into a beautiful butterfly. Alongside this, the children will explore how they themselves have grown and changed since they were babies, while also looking at how the people, familiar places, and environments around them change over time.

Communication and Language

This term, Reception and Nursery children will be encouraged to use talk to help work out problems and organise thinking and activities. They will also be encouraged to use sentences to explain how things work and why they might happen.

How can you help?

Model and prompt your child with explaining their ideas.

Maths

In Nursery, we will be subitising numbers 1 to 3 and counting up to 10. We will also be making collections comparing amounts using language like fewer, more or same. We will explore patterns and how to continue ABAB patterns.

In Reception, we will be looking at grouping and sharing, doubling, identifying and making own repeating patterns, describing positions and explore mapping.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We'll be exploring changes this term. We'll discuss how we grow and develop, from babies to children ready for new adventures. We'll also prepare for transitions, like moving from Nursery to Reception or Reception to Year One, helping children feel confident for new experiences and environments. We'll focus on supporting each other through these changes and adapting to new situations.

How can you help? Share stories at home about growing up or experiencing new beginnings.



Expressive Arts and Design

Reception and Nursery will be experimenting with diverse materials and techniques to create vibrant artwork inspired by life cycles. Alongside this, they will be practicing new songs and musical pieces as we continue our exciting exploration of theater and performance.

Physical Development

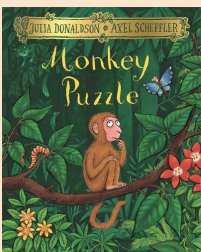

How can you help? Have a go at racing at home!

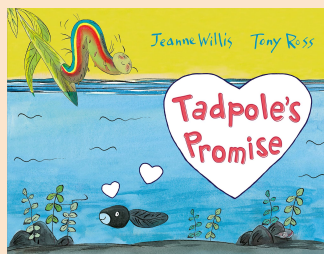
Transition

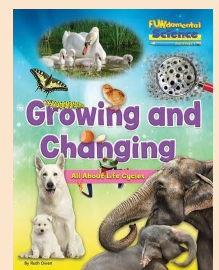
