This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term we will begin by reading *The Invisible* and writing a persuasive letter. We will look at using exclamation and question sentences. After this, we will be writing a set of instructions on how to make a pencil case which will link to our DT.

How can you help? Encourage your child to access [Spelling Shed](#) at home.

Maths

We will begin the term by looking at money where we will recognise pounds and pence. We will also combine coins to make an amount. We will then move on to look at fractions. We will recognise, name and find quarters, thirds and halves of amounts and shapes.

How can you help? Encourage your child to play [Numbots](#) regularly. Practise the 2, 5 and 10 times table with your child.

Science


This term we will be exploring plants with our focus question being 'How do bulbs and seeds work?' The children will conduct an investigation to discover the best conditions needed when growing a plant.

How can you help? Show your children any plants or flowers that are growing and discuss how this is happening.



History

This term we will be learning all about The Tudors with a focus on the question, 'What makes the Tudors an interesting family to learn about?' We will look at the life of Henry VIII, his children and explore what happened during their reign.



DT Day

For our DT day this term, we will be designing and making a pencil case. We will be sewing fabric and having a go at adding decoration.

Music

For music we will be exploring Gamelan music and exploring what it is. We will also look at how music can be made up of different layers, called texture.

RE

We will be looking at the teachings of Jesus with the key question of 'How and what does Jesus teach Christians?' We will look at the stories of 'The Good Samaritan' and 'The Lost Son'.



Art
