This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

Phonics - Literacy

Children in Reception will continue to be encouraged to read and write small phrases and sentences. They'll continue to practice their single sounds and special friends, working at getting faster with their blending. Children will be challenged to use 'Fred in your Head' when reading.

How can you help? In Nursery we will continue to work on writing our names, and the letters and sounds that are in them, please also continue to practise at home. Children starting school in September will learn to name RWI cards. Reception children should continue practicing to both read and write words which include special friends. Understanding the World

This term we'll be exploring stories from different cultures and learn about their unique traditions and lessons. This will encourage children to develop a deeper understanding of the world around them, including similarities and differences between other cultures and our own. Children will also be encouraged to develop their communications skills and tell their own stories.

Communication and Language

This term, Reception and Nursery children will explore storytelling. As they create and share narratives, they'll expand their vocabulary and descriptive language. This also builds crucial communication and listening skills as we discuss stories and texts. Continue to encourage children to question and reason. **How can you help?** Encourage children to tell stories by giving them a character to bring to life.

Expressive Arts and Design

Reception and Nursery will be diving into the exciting world of storytelling! This term, we're going to become amazing authors and performers, dramatically telling our very own stories.

Maths

In Nursery, we will be exploring numbers to 5; adding, taking away and subtracting. We will also learn the properties of shapes and how to use them for construction.

In Reception, we counting beyond 20 as well as moving onto sharing and grouping numbers. We'll continue developing our skills around numbers to ten and begin manipulating, composing and decomposing shapes.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we focus on the value of friendship and what it truly means to be a supportive friend. As we explore storytelling and myths or legends from the past, we will also be focusing on empathy—encouraging the children to consider the feelings of both the characters they encounter and the people in their everyday lives.

We will discuss what it means to be a kind friend in digital spaces, learn how to identify what is appropriate to share online, and—most importantly—ensure the children know how to ask for help if something they see makes them feel worried or uncomfortable.
