Phonics - Literacy

Children in Reception will continue their phonics lessons, moving onto special friends; sounds like 'sh, th, ck'. They should continue blending simple words such as 'log', 'bag', and 'hen'. Children will also be encouraged to use their 'fred fingers' to sound out words and write them down.

Maths

In Maths we are looking at numbers 0 to 8, focusing on subitising, one more, one less, composition and conceptual subitising. We are also going to make pairs discussing odd and even numbers and to find and make a double to 8. In addition, we are going to compare mass and capacity.

In Nursery, we will be exploring subitising up to 3, taking and adding up to 5 and comparing quantities.

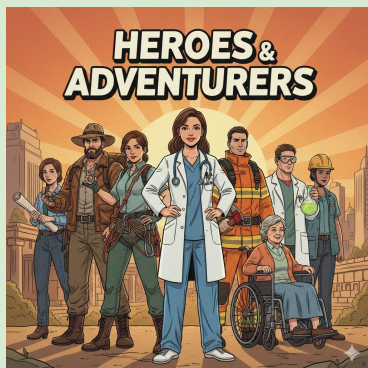
Understanding the World

This term, we're celebrating the Heroes & Adventurers who shape our world. We'll be traveling from the highest peaks of Mount Everest to the furthest reaches of outer space!

We will explore the lives of legendary explorers, discover the courage of advocates like Malala Yousafzai, and honor the "everyday heroes" in our own community—like the doctors and nurses who keep us safe. Our journey will take us through the history of brave missions, from the engineering of powerful rockets to the resilience of those who face great challenges to help others.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we are focusing on Wellbeing and exploring how expressing ourselves, practicing kindness, and showing gratitude can help us feel happy and healthy. During our Circle Time sessions, we will be talking about how we can share our feelings, learn how we can overcome challenges, and discover how those experiences help us grow. We will be using cooperation and teamwork to tackle tasks together, thinking about how we feel at the beginning, middle, and end of our journeys to understand our emotions and build our confidence. Expressive Arts and Design

We will continue to visit the art room for some of our lessons, exploring and learning to use a range of new materials and techniques from water colour to cross hatching with crayons. We'll also be accessing the art table in our classrooms to paint planets, make binoculars or clay medals for the heroes in our community. Communication and Language

Reception and Nursery will be encouraged to express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences. We'll ask them to offer their opinions and ideas on what they would bring to space or an adventure and develop reasoning around why they agree or disagree with each other's suggestions.

How can you help?

Ask your child about where they would go and what they would take on an adventure with them. Encourage them to speak in full sentences and say why they think that would be important to bring.

Physical Development

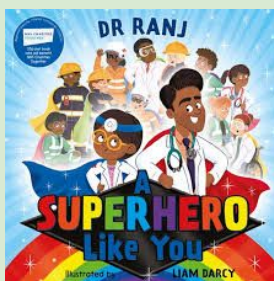
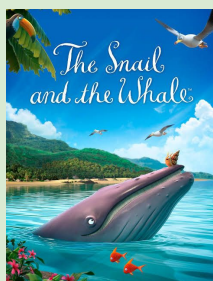
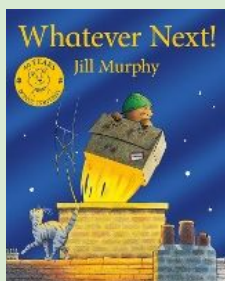
This term the children will focus on developing basic movements needed for Physical development and sport in their PE lessons. They will work on how to apply these movements in games.
