## Year 6 Learning Flyer - Term 5

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

### English

Firstly, we will be writing a balanced argument based on one of William Shakespeare's play Macbeth, We will be exploring and writing arguments to the question: Is Lady Macbeth good or evil?. After this, we will be writing a journalistic report about the true story of the Three Little Pigs!

### Maths

This term we will be recapping our prior learning, consolidating our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages as the pupils prepare for the SATs tests in May.

### Science

In science this term, we will be looking at the Human Body. In this topic, we will explore the functions of vital human organs and also look at the circulatory system, which will link to an explanation text that children will be writing in future English topics.

### Design Technology

In DT, pupils will be designing and building a fully functional electrical toy, based on products that they research.

### History

This term, our topic will be 'The Cold War' We will look at what the Cold War was as well as learning what happened during the Arms Race.

### Physical Education

With the sports coach, the children will be developing their skills and understanding of Trigolf. Our indoor sessions will be focussing on paralympic sports of: seated volleyball, boccia and goalball.

### Computing

In our computing, we will continue to explore robotics, as the children learn how to code the Ohbot.

They will also explore online safety, preparing them for the next steps on their journey to secondary school.

### Art

This term year 6 will be exploring collagraph/printmaking techniques and will use a variety of materials to achieve texture and movement.

The children will create their own beautiful sea/beach themed collagraphs inspired by the Scottish printmaker Fenella Ross.

### Geography

Our topic this term is 'Africa'. We will locate Africa on a map and explore different ancient african empires. As well as this, we will look at major issues that are faced in Africa such as food security and desertification.

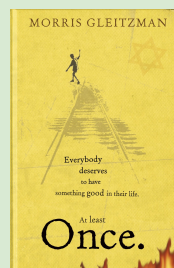
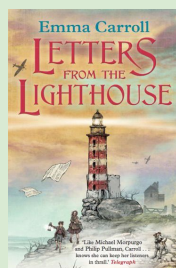
### RE
