Year 2 Learning Flyer - Term 6

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

English

This term, our English focus will be on ensuring our sentences use a range of punctuation, conjunctions and suffixes. We will begin by writing a recount about our superhero day. After this we will write a diary entry as if we are David Attenborough on an extraordinary journey. In Reading we will explore stories such as 'Traction Man as well as information texts and answer many questions about these.

How can you help? Practise joining letters with your child. Read for 10 minutes with your child each night.

Maths

This term we'll dive into Statistics, learning how to collect and show information using tallies and pictograms. To wrap up the term, we will explore Position and Direction, where the children will have fun describing movement and creating their own patterns.

How can you help? Encourage your child to gather a mix of items (like different fruits, colored socks, or cutlery) and have your child sort them into groups.

Science

Our science topic this term is 'The Human Body'. We will look at how our skeleton is made up of bones, how the digestive system works and the circulatory system. We will also investigate how we can prevent germs and diseases.



History

This term we will be looking at 'Powerful voices'. The children will look at a number of significant people both from history and in the modern world. This will include Gandhi, Martin Luther King, Greta Thunberg and David Attenborough. They will explore why these people are seen as important and will learn about their accomplishments.

Computing

This term, we are diving into digital media! The children will be using online software to create beautiful digital artwork inspired by a specific artist. As the term progresses, they will also practice their teamwork skills by collaborating online to create joint art pieces.



Art

This term year 2 will be studying the contemporary artist Sarah Morris and her use of patterns in art. We will also be applying their knowledge of the elements of art to create some magnificent end of year pieces.

DT

This term, the children will take part in a DT day. They will spend the day designing and making a moving picture using sliders and levers.

Music

We will be listening to and exploring a variety of lullabies, before composing our own!

RE

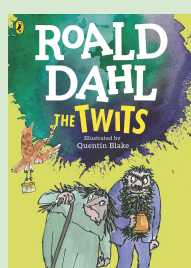
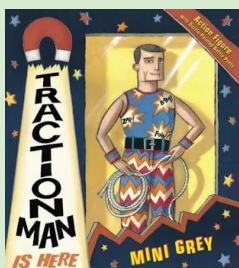
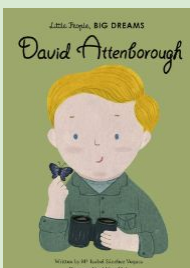
We will look at the symbols and artefacts used across religions to represent key beliefs.
