Choosing a School

Find out about a school

To find out if a school is suitable for your child:



visit the school - most schools have open days and evenings, for dates and times please check the school's website.

ask other parents what they think about the school

check the school's admissions criteria - this sets out how schools choose which children to offer a school place to

read the school's Ofsted reports

learn how Ofsted inspect schools

check school league tables

think about what school transport is available

find out how the school can support your child if you are choosing a school for a child with a special educational need

(if you are an overseas national entering the UK) check you have a <u>right of abode</u>, or that the conditions of your immigration status otherwise permit you to access a state-funded school before you make an application.

Results for Kent Test published 18th October 2023

Kent Test (11+) assessment decisions sent to parents after 4pm.



- 1. **Grammar assessed** choose 4 Grammar schools
- 2. Not Grammar assessedchoose 4 non-grammar (comprehensive) schools.
- 3. If you wish to make a parental appeal- choose your top 3 comprehensive schools and choose one Grammar school as your 4th option. This then gives you the right to appeal.
- 4. Headteacher appeals have already been completed.



On 1 March 2024 KCC will contact Kent parents to inform them of the school they have been offered.

You will receive only ONE offer. E-mail messages will be sent after 4pm to parents who provided an email address on their application, and letters will be posted first class to all other parents. Please be aware that KCC has no control over email delivery times once they have left our servers and some email providers may delay sending the messages to account holders.

Parents are also advised to check their spam mail folders for the email before contacting <u>kentonlineadmissions@kent.gov.uk</u>. All online applicants can also log back on to their online applications after 5pm and view their school offer.

You can also lose your school place if the information you put on your application form is later found to be incorrect.
