Maths To start the term, we will be focusing on length and perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons. The main focus for the rest of the term will be fractions. We will be looking at mixed fractions, improper fractions and equivalent fractions. We will also look at adding and subtracting fractions.   How can you help?
