## Staffing and Classes - September 2025

I am delighted to announce details of staffing and classes for September. Today we have shared with the children who their new class teachers are, together with the support staff in the year group. ## **Transition**

Children have spent the morning in their new classrooms with their new teachers. During the morning teachers have undertaken a range of activities that will enable them to get to know your children and outline clearly the new year group expectations in readiness for September. We very much hope that this morning has enabled children to start the important process of adapting to their new classes.

## Mixed classes

We have decided that classes in the current Year 1 and Year 3 will be mixed. New classes have been organised around our knowledge and understanding of the dynamics and needs of individual children and groups within each year group. We will continue to review this year on year and ensure that classes are organised in a way that leads to optimum learning. We would like to reassure you that our decisions have been carefully considered and based on the best interests of the children. As with any change, it will take time to adjust but as ever we would encourage you to be positive and reassure your child where necessary.
