




Something to ask your child... have they found all of Mrs T's festive gingerbread people who have descended on our beautiful school? How many are there? Are they all the same?

Please remember that the school day starts promptly at 8:50am. Gates will open at 8:40am to allow pupils time to get to class.


#### **Medication**
