#### English

In term 5, we will be writing instructions, and creating a narrative in the style of Katherine Rundell. Whilst working on this we will focus on the reading skills of retrieval, interpretation and authorial choices when writing to further develop our own understanding of how narratives are developed by the author to engage their readers. Our SPAG focus will be on developing characters and settings as well as allowing our writing to flow throughout our texts.

We will begin Term 5 by consolidating the learning we already have done this year. We will then continue to build on our decimals learning by using the four operations with decimals. After that, we will begin a new topic of properties of shape and how to measure angles with a protractor.

#### Geography - South America.

Our main focus this term will be looking at the human and physical geography of South America. We will compare and contrast our findings to where we live.

#### **Physical Education**

#### Spanish (MFL)

Spanish this term will focus on the children being able to recognise and name different items of clothing, this will include being able to describe the clothes by colour.

Our jigsaw learning this term will be based around relationships. We will focus on self-cognition and self-worth and use ways to help build our self-esteem. We will focus on understanding our own qualities and characteristics.
