School Uniform

School uniform displaying the school logo can be purchased via the school website:

Uniform requirements

Jumper	Navy Blue with School logo
Cardigan	Navy Blue with School logo
Fleece	Navy Blue with School logo
Shirt/Blouse	White, long or short sleeved with collar
Trousers/Skirts/Pinafore dresses/Culottes	Plain, dark grey
Socks/Tights	Plain dark colour or white Compulsory (Years 3 - 6) Voluntary (Reception - Year 2)
School Tie	Elasticated Ties Standard Ties
Shoes	Plain/flat black. Trainers are not permitted For safety reasons shoes must be flat and not platforms, boots may not be worn. (Velcro fasteners are easier for younger children to manage)
Hair Accessories	Plain - in school colours (hair bands available in office)
<u>Alternative Summer Uniform</u>	
Short Trousers	Plain, dark grey
Dress	Red/White checked
Shoes	Shoes must be flat - No platforms, opened toed, open back or plastic sandals. Trainers are not permitted.

PE Kit

PE Kit will not need to be purchased until later in the school year when house colours will be allocated.

Jewellery

For safety reasons where ears are pierced, only plain studs may be worn. **No other jewellery should be worn**

Make-Up

No make-up or nail varnish to be worn

Responsibility for pupil's personal property

Swale Academies Trust does not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to the personal property of pupils. Marking each garment of clothing with the child's name is therefore of the greatest importance and we request that all property brought to school is marked.

Children will be regularly reminded of his or her responsibility to look after clothes and property. However, at times, things are mislaid and if they are labelled they may be easily returned to their owners. Items of clothing, which have been handed in as lost property, and which are not marked with the owner's name, are kept in the school office.

Children are asked not to bring valuables, such as jewellery, mobile phones or MP3 players to school and the school does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to such articles. Jewellery is a safety hazard in physical education and at playtimes. The wearing of jewellery is therefore not appropriate and not allowed. In the case of earrings, only stud earrings should be worn to school and must be removed for PE and swimming.

Please note:

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the child's name including socks.

These will be checked by staff periodically. If uniform is found unnamed - staff will name it!
