Your Things

You will have your own coat peg with your name on it. You can hang your coat here. There will be a place in the classroom for you to put your book bag and contact/reading record book in.



You should bring your school water bottle in, cleaned and refilled with water every day.



Letters for home will go in your book bag together with your reading record book.



Snack

During the day you can have a snack at any time.
You will find these at the snack table.

This is usually a piece of fruit or a vegetable.

School will give you a water bottle which you can
take home every day to be cleaned.

You can have a drink of water whenever you like
and fill your bottle up during the day when you
need to.




Lunch

When you stay at school for lunch, you will eat it in the hall.

You will be able to sit with your friends.

An adult you know well will stay in the dining hall while you eat. You will need to listen carefully to instructions when you have to tidy up.

You will need to bring in a packed lunch or order a hot school lunch everyday.



Reading

We hope you enjoy sharing books with your friends and families.

At school your teacher will read you stories every day. The reading area in our classroom is a special place to sit while you are looking at and reading books.

You will be able to find books about things you like. There are books about everything; dinosaurs, pirates and trains, fairy tales, animals and lots more!

This is Fred. Fred will help you with reading your sounds in the classroom.



Writing

Writing is fun! At school you will learn how to form letters correctly and later how to write sentences.

We write while we play all the time; in all of our learning areas. We write at every opportunity!



You will be able to do lots of other activities at school to help with your writing. These include drawing patterns, colouring, making models with play dough, cutting and drawing.



Maths

At school we do lots of mathematical activities. You will do lots of exciting things, such as counting forwards and backwards! Looking at shapes around us, measuring, building and estimating.

Can you see any shapes or numbers around you now?



Work will begin with our new learning area from September 2022.



You will have lots of fun learning both inside and outside.

We will always try to go outside, even in wet weather.

Home Time

When it is time to go home, your mum, dad or someone else you know should wait for you at the white doors.

Your teacher will make sure they see your grown-up before you can go.



You will need to walk to your adult on your own.


What can you do over the summer to help when you start school?
