Dear Parents and Carers.

RE: Returning to School - September 2021

We are writing to inform you of the arrangements that will be in place for our return to school from **Monday 6th September**. Please note the following:



Covid-19

As you will know, the national guidelines regarding COVID-19 and social distancing have now been relaxed. This means that next school year there will no longer be any requirement to keep children in separate 'bubbles', and adults on the school site will no longer be required to wear face coverings.

We understand and respect the fact that some staff and parents on the school site may still choose to wear face masks and may prefer to maintain their distance from others. We ask that everybody's personal choices are respected and that consideration and good manners are shown to all.

Any children or adults who are showing any symptoms of Covid 19, must not enter the school site.



They and all members of their household must self-isolate and arrange to take a PCR test as soon as possible. As previously, if any child develops or presents with symptoms of Covid-19 at school, we will contact you and you will need to collect your child immediately. Your household will then need to self-isolate and arrange for a PCR test to be taken as soon as possible.

You may also have heard that the guidelines for under-18s and for 'double vaccinated' adults who are identified as close contacts of positive Covid cases will be different as from the start of the school year. We will fully update you on the up-to-date guidelines and rules in early September, before your child returns to school.

We hope that the easing of restrictions will allow our pupils to return to a more 'normal' school life and will also allow them to participate in a full range of activities and events.




