We are keen to promote open channels of communication between home and school. If you have any concerns or queries about any aspect of your child's education, you can contact us in the following ways:

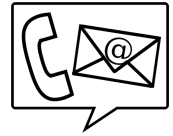


READING RECORDS

For brief messages, please write a note in your child's Reading Record. These are checked daily by somebody in your child's class.

SCHOOL OFFICE

To communicate messages, however short or urgent to class teachers, please email the school office at sbps_office@swale.at. Messages that come into the office are checked regularly and will be passed onto class teachers without delay. Alternatively, ring the office on 01622 752161. ***We will soon be expanding our use of Class Dojo to further improve our communication with parents. Watch this space!***



CLASS TEACHERS

You may feel that a face-to-face meeting is needed in order to discuss and address your concerns. The first point of contact should always be your child's class teacher. They know your children well and are best suited to sort out any queries or issues. Please either speak to your child's teacher at the end of the day or make an appointment via the school office.

SEN AND WELFARE NEEDS

If your query is related to your child's special education or welfare needs, your first port of call should usually be the class teacher. For SEN, you may feel it necessary to have a joint meeting with your child's teacher and our SENCO, Mrs Fulcher. Our Family Liaison Officer (Ms Parkhouse) will also be happy to meet with you to discuss available support for your child's welfare. Please contact the school office to make an appointment.
