'Cakes and Crowns' - Friday 5th May 2023

The event will take place on the school field at 1:30pm and finish at approximately 2.45pm.

On this day, children will be able to wear non-school uniform. For our 'Royal Parade', children should choose an outfit inspired by the Royal Family or the Union flag. They may wish to dress up as a King or Queen or in red, white or blue.

For parents and carers who are attending, children will be dismissed to meet parents and carers on the school field at 1:30pm. You should enter via the gate near Smarties nursery. Parents are invited to bring cake and refreshments to share with their own children. If parents are unable to attend please send your child in to school with a cake.

A programme detailing timings of all the events will be sent separately. .

For those parents who are not attending, children will stay with their class teachers until the end of the school day and will be dismissed as usual on the school playground.

Aftercare will be running as usual (**closes 5pm**).

In the event of bad weather, the parade and all other activities will take place in school. Unfortunately, no parents/carers will be able to attend due to space restrictions as this is a whole school event.
