- **Sign Maker:** Create signs for special OPAL events and areas.

Be a Playground Leader:

- **Ranger Rep:** Tell everyone about OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) at school assemblies! You can do presentations and make announcements.
- **Role Model:** Show everyone how to play safely and have fun in all kinds of weather.

Be a Safety Superhero:

- **Safety Checker:** Help adults check new loose parts to make sure they are safe for everyone to use.
- **Loose Parts Inspector:** Check the loose parts after lunchtime and help decide if anything needs to be recycled or replaced.
