In Term 4, South Borough Primary School will continue to remain open to vulnerable children and children of critical workers unless the DFE guidance changes. As a school, we will always be there to support children of critical workers who are vital to the response of Covid-19. During term 3, we have been able to further support parents and carers by opening Breakfast Club.

As from Monday 22nd February, we will continue to offer in-school places to the children of critical workers, in line with current Government guidance. You do not need to re-apply for a critical worker space.

Please only send your child to school on days in which you are unable to keep your child at home and it is a necessity due to your critical worker role.
