Dear Parents/Carers,

Full return to school for all pupils - 8th March 2021

We are very much looking forward to welcoming all children back to school on 8th March and would like to clarify a few points prior to this date.

Return to school handbook

We have updated our '<u>Return to School Handbook</u>' to give parents and carers as much information as possible about the return on 8th March. Whilst many things are staying the same, I would urge you to look through this booklet carefully and contact the school office if you have any queries. Attendance requirements

As from Monday 8th March all pupils are required to attend school as normal. This means that the current remote learning arrangements will cease from Friday 5th March. The only exception to this will be for children deemed to be 'extremely clinically vulnerable', who are unable to return to school as they are required to 'shield' (and you have received a letter from the NHS confirming this), or where a child is required to self isolate. We will continue to ensure remote learning provision is in place for any such children, so if your child is shielding or self isolating, please contact us as soon as possible so we can work together to put appropriate arrangements in place.

Live learning sessions

Live sessions for all pupils will continue up to and including the morning of **Wednesday 3rd March**. Wednesday afternoon, Thursday & Friday will be time for staff to prepare the school for re-opening on Monday 8th March. There will be no live sessions on these days, however children will still need to complete any work set on their Google classrooms for these 2 days. Any children currently attending school will continue to do so, up until Friday 5th March.

<u>Nursery</u>

Nursery will continue to open for morning sessions only (8:40-11:40am) for the foreseeable future. This is so that we can keep the nursery children together as one bubble.

In school provision - next week

We will continue to provide in school teaching to those children of key workers or vulnerable children who are already attending. Our in school provision is now at capacity for the staffing levels we have. We will therefore not be able to admit any further children into school until Monday 8th March.
